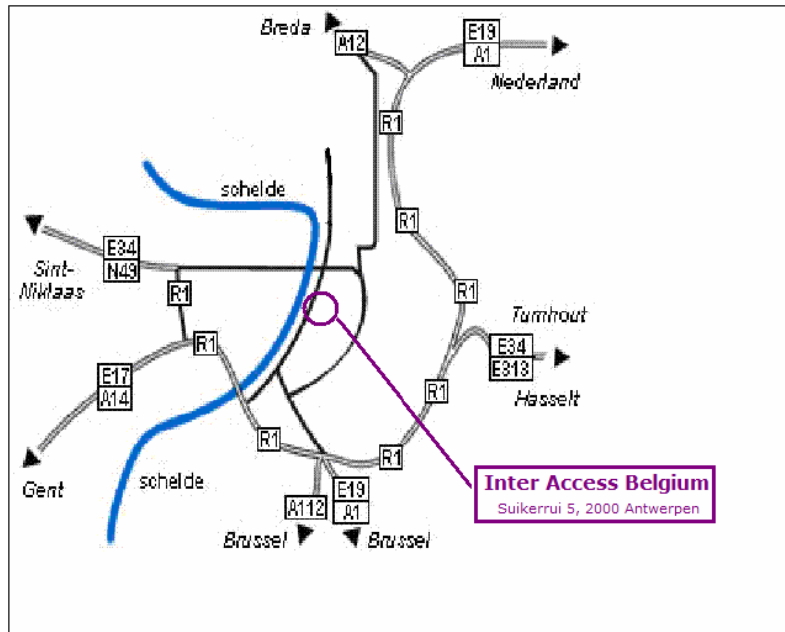

Directions by car

From Brussels

If you are travelling from Brussels, drive through the Craeybeckx tunnel and get in the Gent lane. This will take you to the Ring road/E17, where you take the exit Antwerpen-Centrum. (This is the last exit before the Kennedy tunnel.) Get in the Schelde lane.

Turn left at the first traffic lights and follow the road (about 100 metres) until the first T-junction. By now you have passed by the Vlaamse Kaai (where the Sinksenfoor can be found every year). At the traffic lights on the T-junction you can see the Schelde river straight ahead of you. Get in the lane to turn right. Follow the road along the Schelde. You will pass 3 traffic lights. At the third traffic lights you will see the Hansahuis to the right, above the Corsendonck Stadscafé. 100 metres further down - past the Steen - you will find the Grote Markt car park where you can park your car. Inter Access is at the corner of the Suikerrui and the Ernst van Dijckkaai, in the Hansahuis.

From Gent

If you are travelling from Gent, immediately take the first exit when you leave the Kennedy tunnel. Keep the left lane for Antwerpen-Centrum.

Get in the Schelde lane.

Turn left at the first traffic lights and follow the road (about 100 metres) until the first T-junction. By now you have passed by the Vlaamse Kaai (where the Sinksenfoor can be found every year). At the traffic lights on the T-junction you can see the Schelde river straight ahead of you. Get in the lane to turn right. Follow the road along the Schelde. You will pass 3 traffic lights. At the third traffic lights you will see the Hansahuis to the right, above the Corsendonck Stadscafé. 100 metres further down - past the Steen - you will find the Grote Markt car park where you can park your car. From the Netherlands/Hasselt
